After a brief illness Lillian Sorkin Rose died peacefully at the Hospice of Palm Beach County on January 28th, 2016 at 5 AM. She was born in Carbondale PA on March 6, 1921, and spent her childhood and most of her adult years in Syracuse New York, where she raised her daughters, worked as an executive assistant and was the president of her local chapter of Pioneer Women. Upon retirement, Lillian and her second husband of 40 years, Norman Rose, moved to Florida, where they threw themselves into numerous community and civic activities, and travelled extensively.
